Our Mission

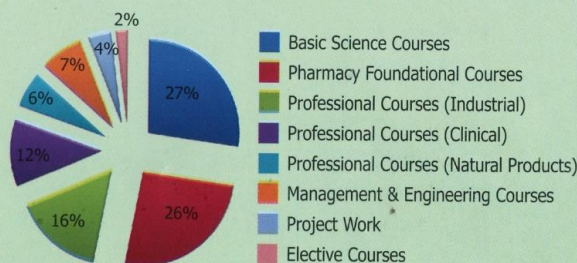
- Provide educational facilities to students for career in pharmacy profession.

Admission Eligibility

The candidate must have completed 10+2 or equivalent with minimum of 50% marks or C+ in aggregate and 50% or C+ in physics, chemistry and biology (PCB) or physics, chemistry and mathematics (PCM).

Those with Diploma in Pharmacy (D Pharm) degree should have secured minimum of 50% in aggregate. Candidate with GCSE A-Level should have minimum 'C' grade in each of the required subjects.

Scholarships

The total duration of program is eight semesters. Each year consists of two semesters. The academic year usually starts in August.

Cost

Total cost of the program is as per KU rule which can be paid in 16 installments.

Evaluation

Performance of the student is accessed through In-semester and End-semester evaluations.

At the end of each semester, students are awarded letter grades as per grade-point-evaluation system.

In order to complete B Pharm, students are required to maintain a minimum of 2.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).

The maximum time allowed to complete the B Pharm degree is seven years from the date of admission into the program.
